National Groups Call for Ambitious Implementation of Canada's Climate Framework

September 13, 2017 (Ottawa, ON) — Catherine Abreu (CAN-Rac), Ian Culbert (CPHA), Tara Peel (CLC), Kim Perrotta (CAPE), Leor Rotchild (CBSR), and Mardi Tindal (UCC) will host an online media briefing this Thursday to discuss and take questions on the release of an open letter to the Canadian government championing the swift and uncompromising implementation of the Pan-Canadian Framework on Climate Change and Clean Growth.

Context:

Signatory organizations represent the diverse interests of millions of Canadians across the country, including workers, businesses, farmers, health professionals, people of faith, and civil society. Signatories include the United Church of Canada, the National Farmers Union, the Canadian Public Health Association, the Canadian Labour Congress, Canadian Business for Social Responsibility, the Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment, and Climate Action Network Canada. The Pan-Canadian Framework on Climate Change and Clean Growth was released in December 2016. It is the first document of its kind that brings the federal government, most provincial and territorial governments, and all major sectors of our economy together on a shared path of climate action to meet or exceed the country's 2030 emissions reduction target. This webinar will outline groups' expectations for ongoing implementation of the Framework.
